Provide control and oversight of the investment delivery programme by:

- Assure delivery of investment programmes by developing and maintaining bespoke management information. Tracking and monitoring KPIs to meet company and regulatory deliverables.
- Up front and retrospective appraisal of project costs, including unit costs, to ensure efficient design and delivery of the work.

- Create and sponsor change requests to the investment plan to ensure our annual performance remains balanced and delivers our overall business objectives.
